What My Informational (non-fiction) Book Must Include...

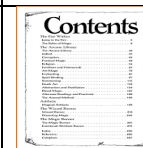


I included a **Front Cover** Which includes a title (or topic), an illustration, photograph, or some other image related to the topic, and the author's name (illustrator name).



2 points

I included a **Table of Contents page**. It shows the headings, and page numbers to help the reader find the information he or she wants to learn about.



2 points

I included **First heading**

It includes/shows **one section** of information I want to teach about my topic.



1st heading

2 points

I included a **second heading**.

It includes/shows **another section** of information I want to teach about my topic.



2nd heading

2 points

I included a **third sub-topic**

It includes/shows **another section** of information I want to teach about my topic.



3rd heading

2 points

I included a **glossary** with important words I used in the text.



2 points

I included **enough "text features"** to better inform the reader. The text features show my creativity. My creativity shows special details that grab the reader's attention.

The reader will want to "reread" my book. (You must include a minimum of 2).

I included a **"Meet the Author"** page. This tells about "Me," the author
