Float (to stay on top of water)



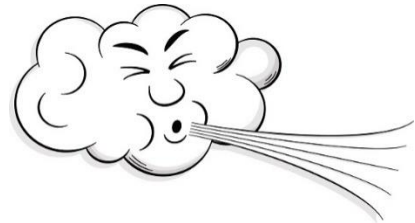
Russ, likes to float above water.
