Supporting details: (the supporting details are the "**facts**" and "**examples**" that "**back up**", or **justify** the **main idea**) Look here



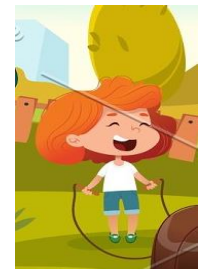
Children can play soccer at the park.

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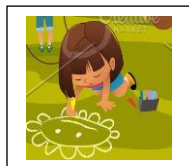
