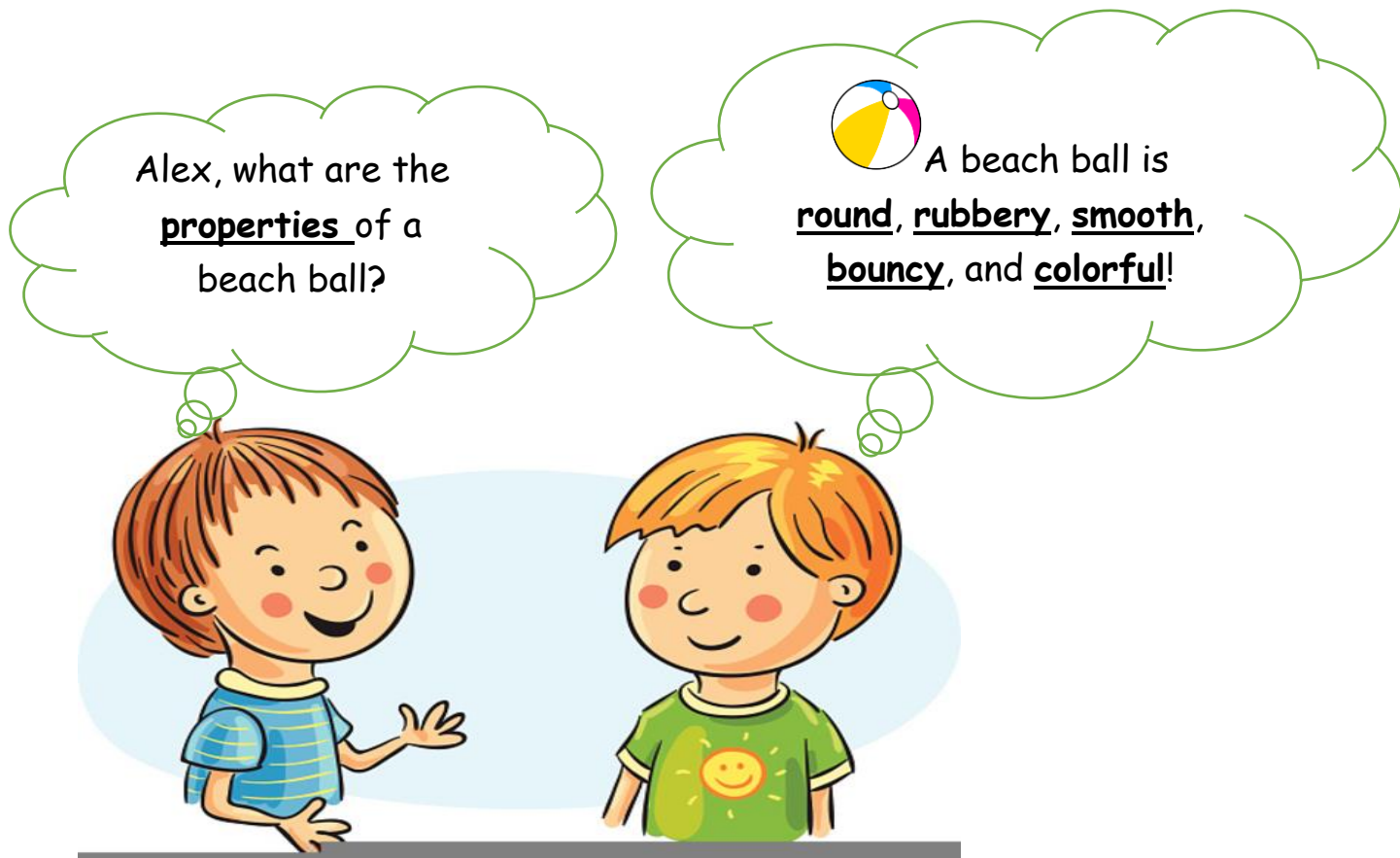


Science Vocabulary Words that relate to Matter

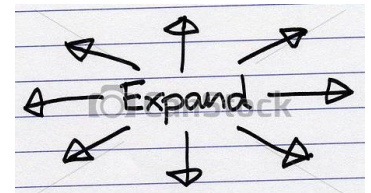
Properties of "Gases"
