

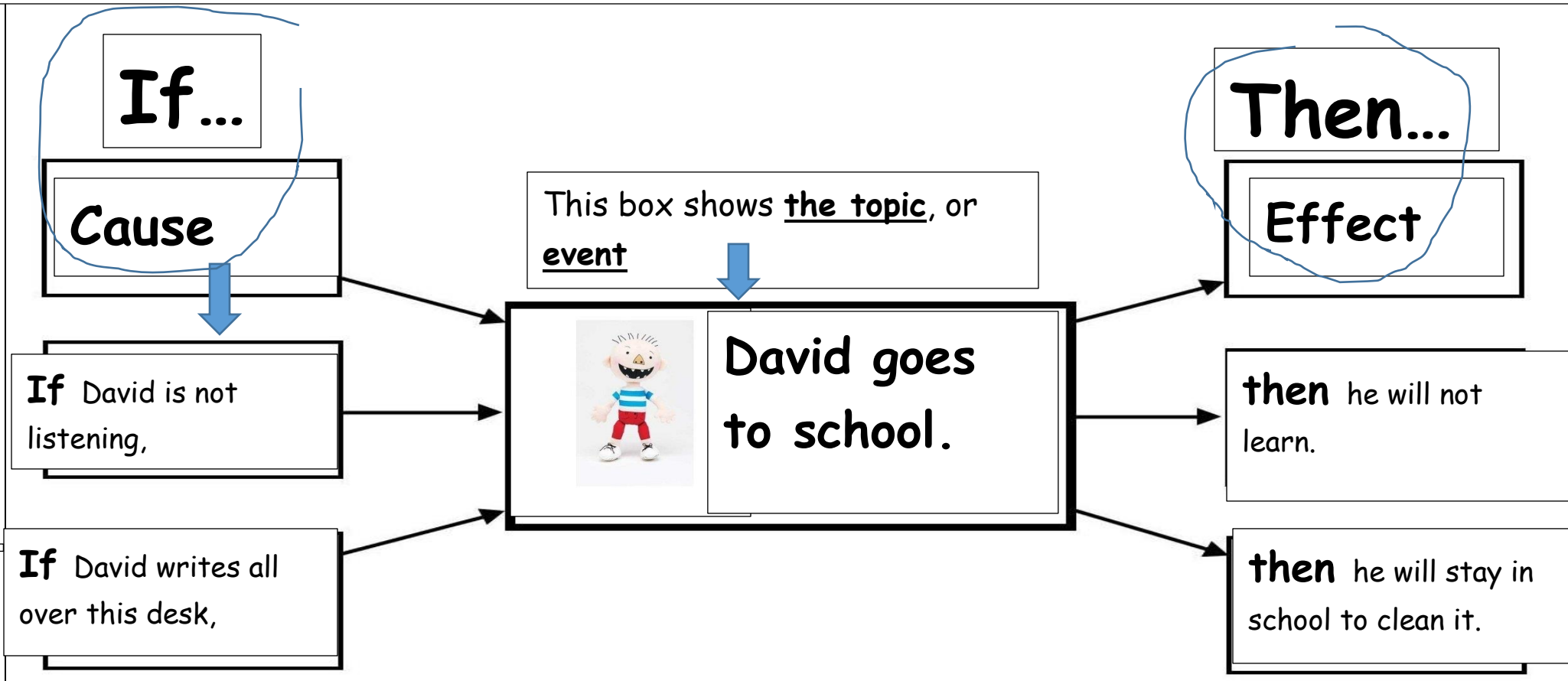
# Cause and Effect (a reading comprehension strategy)
