These are the books students will be assigned to read in RazKids.com. Please look under **"My Assignments."**



 <p>This is an easy and "quick" read. It explains the meaning of... needs, wants, goods and services.</p>	 <p>Since students will learn that a <u>"service"</u> is an action, or job a person does for someone else, they will appreciate how dogs can also provide services in a community.</p>	

Carefully study the sheets below to help you understand
"Goods," and **"Services."**

People (who live in a community) depend on goods and services. **Goods** are things or **items** you buy. Goods can be **needs** or **wants**.


A **Service** is an **action** (or "job") that a person does for someone else. Study the examples below.

These are "Goods"	These are "Services"
 <p>A car is a "good" you buy. You buy it as a "need," or a "want."</p>	 <p>A "car wash" is a service. It is an action (or job) that a person does for you. You pay for a service.</p>
 <p>A hair brush and blow dryer are "goods" you buy. You buy them as a "need," or a "want."</p>	 <p>A hair cut is a service. It is an action (or job) that a person does for you. You pay for a hair cut.</p>
 <p>A pizza is a "good" you buy. You buy it as a <u>need</u>, or a <u>want</u></p>	 <p>Pizza delivery is a service. It is an action (or job) that a person does for you. You pay for pizza delivery.</p>



In this picture, you see a community. A community offers goods and services.

Look at **George's Restaurant**



If you eat at George's Restaurant, you are buying a service.
You are paying people to cook and serve you food.

The food items you eat, are goods. "Things" you buy are "goods."
