

What are Plural Nouns?

"Plural" means = "more than one." **"Plural nouns"** name many.

Plural nouns end in "s."

*I see three **cats**.*





A **"singular" noun** means 1. It does not end in "s."

Example: *I see one **cat**.*

Words with the "oi" "oy" sounds.



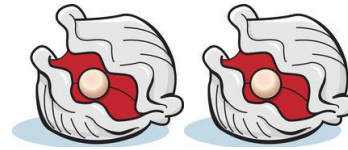

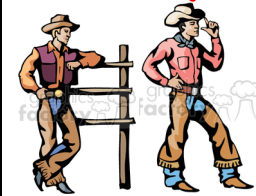


We found two oysters on the sand, along the beach.
