


**Synonyms**

= words that have the same meaning (or similar)

small



little



**Antonym**

= Words that have the opposite meaning (different)

big

**Spelling Words (Synonyms)** Synonyms are words that have the same or similar meaning (words that mean almost the same). **Antonyms** are words that mean the opposite. Look below ↓

Our friend Tom, who's a fast runner, must train to be a swift driver to join a car race.

6

healthy 

sick  ill

Tina is feeling sick this morning. She thinks she's too ill to play with her friends.

7

dry 

wet  soaked

My clothes got wet during the water balloon game, but my shoes were soaked the most!

Fall 

jump  leap

Marcus is excited to jump out of bed to get ready to leap on his trampoline.
